Exclusive to Dogs Bay Training is our Pack Rehabilitation Center! When we take a dog into our home, it is our responsibility to fulfill their basic instinctual needs so they can achieve balance. There are things only dogs can teach dogs, and dog to dog interaction is critical for proper social development. Dogs not having access to what they know instinctually is the foundation of most behavioral issues due to pent up energy and frustration. At the Pack Rehabilitation Center your dog will learn proper greeting rituals, social pack order, how to communicate appropriately with other dogs, work out dominance issues, overcome fear issues, etc. Everything is done under a trainer's supervision and direction. Giving your dog the opportunity to be a part of a real dog pack will help keep your dog balanced and happy. This is not doggie daycare.
